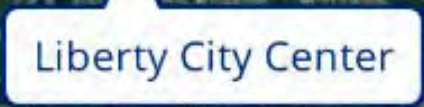

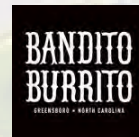
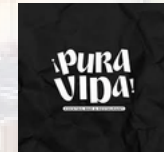

Downtown Revitalization & Growth Plan

A bold 10-year strategic plan created by Downtown Greensboro Inc. and city partners, focused specifically on revitalizing and transforming the downtown core into a more vibrant, walkable, and economically productive district.

Key elements and economic impacts:

- Mixed-use redevelopment across downtown; including former News & Record site and other major parcels targeted for housing, retail, and office uses.
- Goal to attract ~5,000 new residents downtown, which supports sustained demand for restaurants, retail, services, and cultural amenities.
- Add or expand over 100 ground-floor businesses and ~3,000 jobs in the downtown area through new commercial activity and redevelopment.
- Infrastructure enhancements (streetscapes, pedestrian space, lighting, accessibility) to stimulate foot traffic and strengthen downtown as a destination hub.

This plan is being implemented with private and public partnerships and is designed to accelerate the downtown economy by enhancing quality of life alongside commercial activity; making the core more attractive for investors, residents, businesses, and visitors.

Toyota Charges into U.S. Battery Manufacturing

Toyota has launched its first U.S.-based automotive battery manufacturing facility in Liberty, North Carolina, located at the Greensboro-Randolph Megasite. This marks Toyota's first battery plant outside of Japan and its 11th manufacturing operation in the United States. The project represents a \$13.9 billion investment and spans approximately 1,850 acres, positioning the Piedmont Triad as a growing center for advanced manufacturing and clean energy technology.

At full buildout, the facility is expected to create approximately 5,100 new jobs, delivering a significant economic boost to the region. Toyota has also announced plans to invest up to an additional \$10 billion across its U.S. operations over the next five years, bringing its total U.S. investment to nearly \$60 billion. This large-scale commitment reinforces long-term confidence in North Carolina's workforce, infrastructure, and business climate.

The plant will produce advanced lithium-ion batteries to support Toyota's expanding lineup of hybrid, plug-in hybrid, and battery-electric vehicles. Once fully operational, the facility will include up to 14 production lines with an annual capacity of approximately 30 gigawatt-hours, supplying batteries to Toyota vehicle assembly plants across the country. The project is expected to generate lasting ripple effects throughout the Greensboro region, supporting supplier growth, workforce development, housing demand, and broader economic expansion.
